CONSTITUTION AND CLUB RULES

1. NAME.

- 1.1. The Club shall be called BREDHURST JUNIORS FOOTBALL CLUB.
- 1.2. The Club colours will be royal blue and white. Shorts will be predominantly royal blue. Club colours will be worn at all home games as per the Medway News Youth League rules.
- 1.3. The second kit colours shall be optional.

2. OBJECT.

- 2.1. The object of the Club is to promote sportsmanship, interest and enjoyment in all aspects of football for children, young people and adults regardless of their ethnicity, disability, age or gender.

3. AFFILIATION.

- 3.1. The Club will be affiliated to the Kent County Football Association or any Association or organisations of similar interests and aims.

4. MEMBERSHIP.

- 4.1. A member is defined as Club officer or a registered participating player who may be represented by a parent/guardian for the purpose of voting.
- 4.2. Annual registration is compulsory for any boy/girl who wishes to play football for one of the Clubs teams but membership is not a guarantee for selection in the team and therefore it is possible that a member may not actually play football for the Club team during the season.
- 4.3. Girls who register with the Club may be subject to age restrictions in accordance with the rules of the Medway News Youth League or any other league we are members of.
- 4.4. Registered participating players are required to pay weekly training subscription fees and match subscription fees.
- 4.5. Subscription fees will be decided for the forthcoming season by the Club Committee and submitted for approval to the Annual General Meeting.
- 4.6. Any member joining the Club after the 31st of January of the current season will not be eligible for an end of season loyalty trophy.
